Happy New Year and see you all at Kenilworth. Stay safe.





Hi Everyone,

For those members who were unable to attend our December Rally, I was pleased to announce that our grant application for the purchase of a defibrillator has been approved. I received a phone call on Tuesday 7th December from my local State Member, Ms Kim Richards, to advise our grant had been sucessful and that we would soon be receiving a confirmation email from the Gambling Community Fund.

Attached are the two letters I received regarding the approval of the grant. The grant money of \$3,250 has already been deposited into our bank account and I have sent information to the Paramedic John Bradbury, who came to the Maleny Rally in September, 2020 to give us a presentation on using a defibrillator. John will go through the information I have received from various suppliers and advise which defibrillator would be the most appropriate for our needs and it will then be purchased.
