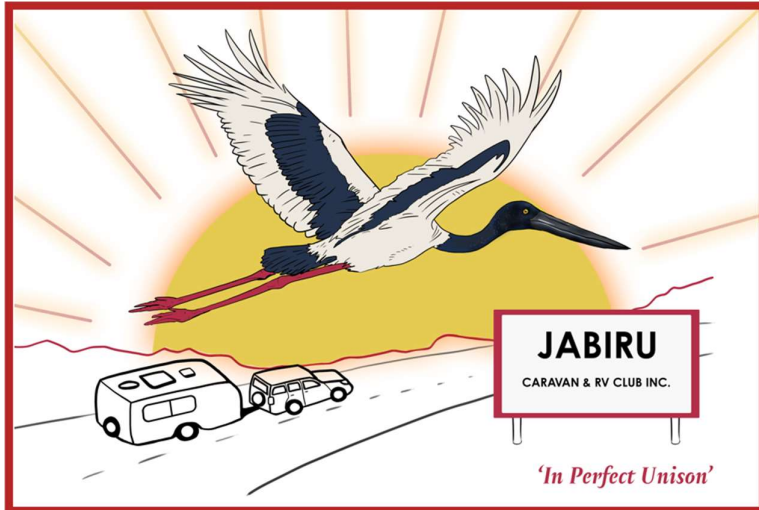

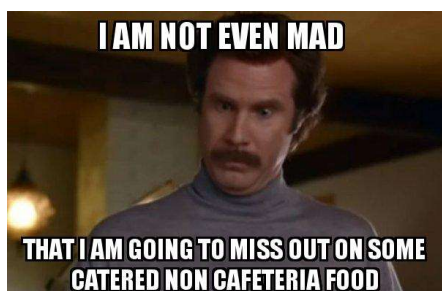
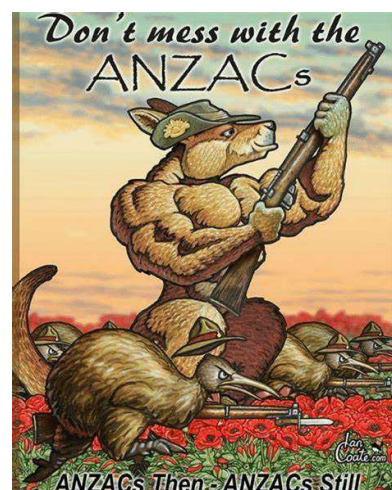


A few of us had a go at lawn bowls.....not overly successful and we didn't try too many times because the professionals came out to play....so there was nothing for it....but a trip to the bar!

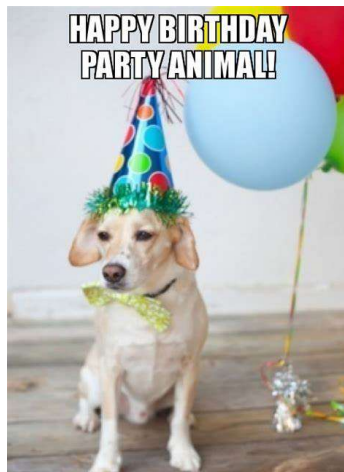
