

A few people made it to the Christmas Tree Farm and the amazing Christmas shop. Some also visited Castle Glen and the Jersey Cow café.


I learnt a new game this Rally.....mahjong......as I think I said a few times....any game that requires a book and some serious thought is probably not going to be top of my hit list!
